I moved from New Orleans to Santa Fe in the summer of 1973. I abandoned *Laissez Les Bon Temp Rouler* to envelop The Land of Enchantment. I summoned the dizzying forces of the wind and snow and the turquoise sky and red desert sands to create the seven panels of this expressionist painting.
